



European HIV Testing Week is renamed to European HIV-Hepatitis Testing Week to mark the inclusion of hepatitis testing in 2015

[HIV in Europe](#) is pleased to announce that testing week, now in its third year, has expanded for 2015 to include hepatitis and is now named [European HIV-Hepatitis Testing Week](#). This year, European HIV-Hepatitis Testing Week will take place from 20-27 November 2015.

The announcement coincides with World Hepatitis Day 2015. Over 13 million people in the WHO European Region live with chronic hepatitis B infection and over 15 million with chronic hepatitis C infection, leading to 400 deaths every day. Testing and linkage to care is crucial in order to halt this silent epidemic which is why the European HIV-Hepatitis Testing Week is including hepatitis this year.
