Thanks for your patience - the results of the 2015 European Testing Week are now available! **417 partners** participated in the 2015 European Testing week, which for the first time included hepatitis testing. Of those, **47% submitted the evaluation survey**. The majority were **NGOs/CSOs (66%)**. The general population was most frequently targeted (66%), and **97% of survey respondents did HIV activities, 45% hepatitis C activities and 28% hepatitis B activities**, including testing and outreach testing and awareness-raising.
