The European Test Finder

In support of Testing Week, HIV in Europe, Terrence Higgins Trust, NAM and ECDC have been working to update the [European Test Finder](#).

New functions to the Test Finder include:

- Expanding the HIV testing sites to include all countries in the wider WHO European region
- Expanding the listing to include those HIV testing sites which also offer STI testing in the wider WHO European region
- Expanding the listing to include those HIV testing sites which also offer hepatitis testing in the wider WHO European region
- Expanding the number of languages the Test Finder is translated into (German, English, Spanish, French, Italian, Portuguese and Russian)

For 2016, there is also a widget which will enable you to embed the Test Finder on your own website. Adding the widget to your site will allow your users to find their nearest test centre without leaving your site. This widget can easily be added to your site using a single line of HTML code.
