To help launch Spring European Testing Week, European Testing Week partner, [Cepheid](#), will be hosting a live webinar, "Early diagnosis of HIV and use of molecular Point-of-Care HIV testing as part of a

comprehensive strategy to end HIV transmission" this Wednesday, 15 May from 1:00-2:00 PM CET.
